Pakistan NA dissolved

PM Sharif holds talks with Oppn leader for caretaker premier

Imran's party to observe 'Thanksgiving Day' as PDM govt bows out

PTI ■ ISLAMABAD

Pakistan President Arif Alvi formally dissolved the National Assembly three days ahead of its mandated period following which outgoing Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif held formal consultations with the Leader of the Opposition on Thursday over the nomination for a caretaker premier to conduct the general elections later this year.

Sharif will continue to perform his duties as the premier until the appointment of a caretaker prime minister.

A notification issued by the Presidential Palace on Wednesday late night said the National Assembly was dissolved under Article 58 of the Constitution.

According to Article 58, if the President fails to dissolve the assembly within 48 hours after the Prime Minister has recommended so, the assembly automatically stands dissolved. "The Prime Minister's advice at para 6 of the summary is approved," President Alvi said in a statement.

"President Dr Arif Alvi dissolved the National Assembly. The President dissolved the National Assembly on the advice of the Prime Minister under Article 58-1 of the Constitution," his office posted on social media platform X, formerly known as Twitter.

On Thursday, Sharif held a formal round of consultation with the Leader of the Opposition in the National Assembly Raja Riaz over the nomination for the caretaker premier at the Prime Minister's House. They have three days as per the Constitution to finalise a name for the caretaker prime minister. When asked about any names from his side for nomination, Riaz said, "I bear three names in mind."

According to local media reports, three names have been proposed, including two nom-

Islamabad (PTI): Jailed former Pakistan prime minister Imran Khan's Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf party is observing Thursday as "Thanksgiving and Salvation Day" as the 16-month tenure of the ruling Pakistan Democratic Movement (PDM) government ended.

President Arif Alvi dissolved the National Assembly on Wednesday night on the recommendation of outgoing Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif, marking an end to the current government's tenure three days ahead of its mandated period.

Sharif will continue to perform his duties as the caretaker prime minister.

The notification for the dissolution of the assembly issued by the Presidential Palace said the National Assembly was dissolved under Article 58 of the Constitution. With the National Assembly dissolved, former

prime minister Khan's party PTI announced on Wednesday that it will observe August 10 (Thursday) as "Thanksgiving and Salvation Day", Geo News reported. In a statement issued on Wednesday, the PTI core committee decided to commemorate the day, as the 16-month tenure of the Pakistan Democratic Movement (PDM) government will end tonight. The PDM alliance replaced the government of Khan in April last year.

The PTI has decided to put forth a detailed analysis of the "devastation" caused by the PDM-led incompetent government before the nation, read the statement. The former ruling party will inform the masses about censorship of media and repression against journalists, it added. Details related to skyrocketing inflation and economic disaster will also be brought before the nation, the statement said.

Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) will pick the caretaker prime minister within two days from the names proposed by the opposition and the government.

Shehbaz: Massive crime, moment of shame if report true

Pakistan's outgoing Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif on Thursday said if the news report by an American publication claiming to contain the evidence of a US conspiracy to topple Imran Khan's government last year is true, then it was tantamount to a "massive crime" and "would have been a moment of shame". Sharif was referring to a report published in The Intercept, an online US-based news organisation, which claimed to have obtained the "secret" diplomatic cable that, according to former prime minister Khan, led to the fall of his government in April last year.

Khan, 70, is currently serving a three-year jail term after he was sentenced by a court in a corruption case last week.

The purported cipher (secret diplomatic cable) contained an account of a meeting between US State Department officials, including Assistant Secretary of State for the Bureau of South and Central Asian Affairs Donald Lu, and Pakistani envoy Asad Majeed Khan. In an interview with WE News, Sharif said, "If god forbid this government had come from a US conspiracy, then it would have been a moment of shame for us." "If the contents of the cipher are published (in the international newspaper), and are true, then it is a massive crime," Sharif, who recommended the dissolution of

Pakistan's National Assembly on Wednesday night, added. The outgoing prime minister said two meetings of the National Security Committee were held on the cipher issue under his leadership. In one of the meetings, former ambassador and Foreign Secretary Asad Majeed clearly stated that there was no discussion of a conspiracy in his meeting with the senior US diplomat Lu. He said former army chief Gen Qamar Javed Bajwa and other service chiefs also confirmed that there was no conspiracy against Pakistan, adding that Majeed too had stated that there was no question of a conspiracy at all.

Sharif underlined that Khan had said that the conspiracy to topple his government was hatched because of his growing relations with Russia, "then how could we get oil from Russia?"

Sharif reiterated that Khan's allegations were a "bunch of lies" from "head to toe" and there was no reality in them. Earlier in the day, outgoing Interior Minister Rana Sanaullah called for a probe to determine the authenticity of the source document used in The Intercept report.

Kim calls for military to sharpen war plans

North Korean leader Kim Jong Un ordered his military to sharpen its war plans and signed off on expanding combat operations of frontline units, state media said Thursday, as the United States and South Korea prepare for a large-scale combined military exercise.

Condemning the allies' expanding drills as invasion rehearsals, Kim has used them as a pretext to further accelerate his weapons demonstrations, which have included the testing-firings of more than 100 missiles since the start of 2022, driving tensions on the Korean Peninsula to their highest point in years.

Experts say Kim's nuclear push is aimed at forcing the United States to accept the idea of the North as a nuclear power so he can eventually negotiate economic and security concessions from a position of strength.

Thursday's meeting of the North Korean ruling Workers' Party's central military commission, which Kim controls as chairman, was to discuss advancing his military's war readiness and establishing offensive countermeasure plans to deter his adversaries,

which state media said were getting more blatant in their "reckless military confrontation" with the North.

After talks of boosting North Korean frontline units and stepping up war drills to incorporate new strategies and weapons, Kim signed an order to implement unspecified "important military measures." Pyongyang's official Korean Central News Agency said. During the meeting, Kim stressed that the military must acquire "more powerful strike means" to bolster his nuclear deterrent and make speedier deployments of those weapons to combat units. He called for the country's munitions industry to step up mass production of various weapons and systems, and for the military to actively conduct "actual war drills" to digest those systems and enhance its war-fighting capabilities, KCNA said.

Photos of the meeting published by state media showed Kim pointing to spots in a blurred map of the Korean Peninsula. The spots appeared to be the metropolitan region surrounding the South Korean capital of Seoul, where half of the country's 51 million people live, and an area around the central city of Daejeon, the

location of South Korea's army headquarters. Kim also made personnel changes during the meeting, appointing Vice Marshal Ri Yong Gil as his new chief of general staff to replace Gen. Pak Su Il, KCNA said. When asked about Kim's comments, Lee Sung Joon, spokesperson of South Korea's Joint Chiefs of Staff, said during a briefing that the U.S. and South Korean intelligence authorities were closely monitoring North Korean weapons development activities and possibilities of provocations. He did not discuss it further.

Kim's comments during the meeting echoed what he said last week during a three-day tour of the country's key weapons factories, including a facility that produces launcher trucks for his intercontinental ballistic missiles designed to target the U.S. mainland, and called for significant improvements to the country's arms and war readiness. Kim's visits also included an artillery factory that deepened outside concerns that North Korea was preparing to export artillery and other arms supplies to Russia as President Vladimir Putin reaches out to other countries for support in the war in Ukraine.

Niger: Options few as military junta defies mediation

West African heads of state began meeting Thursday on next steps after Niger's military junta defied their deadline to reinstate the nation's deposed president, but analysts say the bloc known as ECOWAS may be running out of options as support fades for a military intervention.

Nine of the 11 heads of state expected to attend resumed crucial talks at the ECOWAS summit in neighbouring Nigeria.

They include the presidents of Senegal, Ghana, Ivory Coast, Togo, Benin, Guinea-Bissau and Sierra Leone. The non-ECOWAS leaders of Mauritania and Burkina Faso are also at the closed-door meeting. As Niger's junta turns away most efforts at mediation, one analyst asserted that Russian meddling in the country has spiked in the two weeks since mutinous soldiers overthrew democratically elected President Mohamed Bazoum, who has refused to step down and is under house arrest.

The junta announced a new government on Wednesday night. More than half of the 21 positions were filled by civilians. The rest were military appointments. Niger was seen as the last country in the Sahel region south of the Sahara Desert that Western nations could partner with to counter jihadi violence linked to al-Qaeda and the Islamic State group that has killed thousands and displaced millions of people.

The international community is scrambling to find a peaceful solution to the country's leadership crisis.

"Let me tell you, any coup that has succeeded beyond 24 hours has come to stay. So, as it is, they are speaking from the point of strength and advantage," Oladeinde Ariyo, a security analyst in neighbouring Nigeria, said. "So, negotiating with them will have to be on their terms."

Nigerian President Bola Ahmed Tinubu is leading the ECOWAS push. On Wednesday,

a Nigerian delegation led by the Emir of Kano, Khalifa Muhammad Sanusi, met the junta's leader, Gen. Abdourahmane Tchiani. The Emir was one of few people allowed to meet Tchiani. Acting US Deputy Secretary of State Victoria Nuland met with the coup leaders earlier this week but was denied access to both Tchiani and Bazoum. A separate delegation comprised of ECOWAS, the United Nations and the African Union was barred from coming at all.

West Africa's regional bloc has failed to stem past coups throughout the region. Niger is the fourth country in the 15-member state bloc to have experienced a coup in the last three years. The bloc imposed harsh economic and travel sanctions and threatened to use military force if Bazoum was not reinstated by Sunday, a deadline the junta ignored. There is no indication the coup leaders are willing to budge on reinstating Bazoum, who says he is being held hostage in his residence with his wife and son.

An advisor to Bazoum who was not authorised to speak about the situation due to the sensitivity of it told The Associated Press on Wednesday that the family is without water and electricity and subsisting on rice and canned goods because food is running out.

UN deputy spokesman Farhan Haq said he was very concerned about reports of the "deplorable living conditions" Bazoum and his family were in and called for the president's immediate release.

But as the junta becomes more entrenched, the options for negotiations are becoming limited, said Andrew Lebovich, a research fellow with the Clingendael Institute. "It's very difficult to say what might come out of it, but the fact that the initial deadline passed without intervention and that the (junta) has continued to hold a fairly firm line, indicate that they think they can outlast this pressure," he said.

Jail term for owning LGBTQ+ Swatch in Malaysia

Kuala Lumpur (AP): Malaysia's government said Thursday that all Swatch products that contain lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender or queer elements — including watches, wrappers and boxes — were banned, warning that anyone found with one could be jailed for up to three years.

The ban has been published in the Federal Gazette — which makes it official — as part of a printing law that includes distribution and possession, citing concerns that such products were detrimental to the nation's morality. Malaysia, which is predominantly Muslim, already criminalizes same-sex relationships, with punishments ranging from caning under Islamic laws to 20 years in prison for sodomy under colonial-era civil laws. In May, authorities raided Swatch stores and confiscated more than 160 watches from its Pride Collection. Some of the watches have rainbow colours while others are in a choice of six single colours that correlate to the gay pride flag, with two rainbow loops on their straps.

Swatch contested allegations that the watches were harmful, saying they carried a message of peace and love. The Swiss watchmaking company has sued the government for damages and for the return of the watches. The Home Ministry statement said the products are "detrimental, or possibly detrimental, to morality, public interest and national interest by promoting, supporting and normalising the LGBTQ+ movement which is not accepted by the general public." Anyone found in possession of such Swatch products face up to three years in jail or a fine of up to 20,000 ringgit (\$4,375), it warned.

In July, the government cut short a music festival in Kuala Lumpur after the lead singer of British band The 1975 kissed a male bandmate during their performance in protest of the country's anti-gay laws.
